2. Pregnant or breastfeeding clients should refrain from undergoing neurotoxin injections.
3. Neurotoxin appointments should not be combined with facials, facial peelings, laser, or ultrasound-based treatments.
4. Individuals with neuromuscular disorders should consult with their healthcare provider before considering neurotoxin injections.
5. Clients currently using blood thinners are not suitable candidates for neurotoxin injections.
6. After the treatment, it is recommended to refrain from taking aspirin, ibuprofen, Advil, Motrin, Aleve, Nuprin, Ginkgo Biloba, St. John's Wort, and high doses of Vitamin E for approximately 5 days to minimize the risk of bleeding or bruising at the injection sites.
7. Candidates for neurotoxin injections should not have any skin infections.
8. Active acne may affect the suitability of neurotoxin injections.
