- 5. Clients currently using blood thinners are not suitable candidates for neurotoxin injections.
- 6. After the treatment, it is recommended to refrain from taking aspirin, ibuprofen, Advil, Motrin, Aleve, Nuprin, Gingko Biloba, St. John's Wort, and high doses of Vitamin E for approximately 5 days to minimize the risk of bleeding or bruising at the injection sites.
- 7. Candidates for neurotoxin injections should not have any skin infections.
- 8. Active acne may affect the suitability of neurotoxin injections.
